NATURAL RESOURCES:

- Staff hosted seven Seed Pellet Toss Events across several parks (Cave Creek Regional Park, Estrella Mountain Regional Park, McDowell Mountain Regional Park, Spur Cross Ranch Conservation Area, Usery Mountain Regional Park, and White Tank Mountain Regional Park). Tossing a total of 10,360 seed pellets and scattering over 60 pounds native seed, representing 65 native plant species.
- Staff is on the Southwest Vegetation Management Associations board and helped to coordinate a twoday conference that brought more than 85 attendees to learn about best management practices for invasive species management.
- Staff presented at the Southwest Fire Consortium 4th Annual Conference in Santa Fe, New Mexico, with over 600 participants attending. The presentation was on Wildfire Effects on Saguaros within the Sonoran Desert, raising awareness on the impacts to our Saguaros and the Sonoran desert habitat.
