TAMARISK INVASIVE SPECIES REMOVAL FEBRUARY 10 – MARCH 31, 2025

Crews will be using heavy equipment (wood chippers, chainsaws, loppers, and herbicide application) in the area at Estrella Mountain Regional Park to remove tamarisk trees and shrubs using a bobcat and a masticator. The masticator will be used to grind and shred the vegetation into wood chips, which will be deposited on-site. The team also will perform a foliar treatment on other invasive species within the project area.
